You'll then return indoors to write a short piece, before presenting it to your fellow writers for feedback and general discussion.

6PM-8PM Tools of the Trade

Everyone can write, right? Yes. But not everyone can write well. Give yourself a head start by learning more about, or reminding yourself of, the basics. In this workshop, Will Yeoman tackles brainstorming, grammar, style, atmosphere, character, paragraph construction, self-editing and more. Short exercises, to be shared with your fellow writers for critiquing, will be included along the way. Don't be afraid: it will be fun!

Thursday 27 May

9AM-12PM From Parrots to Poets

Imitating the best travel writers is the quickest route to originality. But you need to be smart about it: you need to analyse what they're doing, extract the formulas and techniques and make them your own. In this workshop, Will Yeoman will discuss basic strategies for close, critical reading, presenting the work of some of the finest travel writers in the business as he goes. He'll then choose one sentence for everyone to riff off and see how close they can get to the original author's style. As usual, you'll read your work to your fellow writers for critiquing and general discussion.
